

# Manfrotto 190Xpro

Our VRDL kits now come with this new tripod that works great with this new tripod that works great with both fisheye lens and the new OneShot 360 lens.

(Note: The tripod has to be taken apart in order fit into the VRDL case)

## Setting up the tripod

1) Take out the Manfrotto tripod and the center column



2) After setting the legs on the tripod, take the center column and place it in the center of the tripod



Note: Be sure to align the column with the entrance of tripod head while pressing the release button. The button should be facing the open end of the tripod head.



3) Turn the dial clockwise to tighten and secure the center column in place



## Disassembling tripod

4) Turn the dial counter clockwise to loosen the the column



5) Once you're done with the tripod, pull the column as far as it will go while simultaneously pushing the release button to unhinge it.

Then push the second release button while pulling the column upward to completely remove it

6) When finished, you should have 2 parts that fit easily into the case



# This is the set up for the Oneshot 360° lens



1) Turn the dial counter clockwise to loosen the the column



2) Pull the center column upwards as far as it will go while simultaneously pressing the release button to unhinge the column.

3) Bend it to A 90° angle. This will allow you to offset your camera from the legs. As well as the make the lens sit upright. (Don't forget to tighten the dial again)
